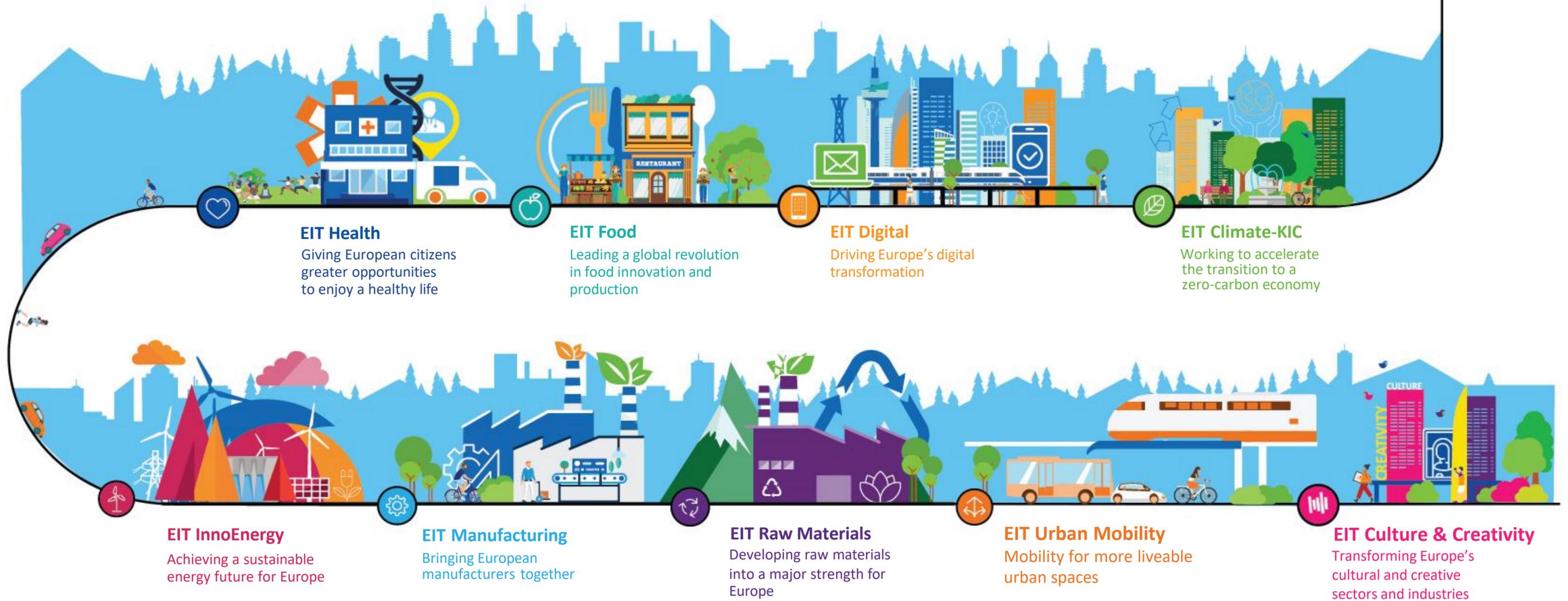
# EIT (European Institute of Innovation and Technology)

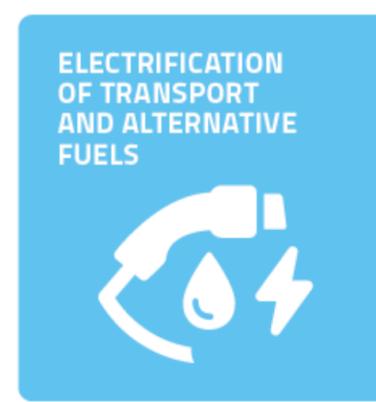


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# Innovation Programme

The objective of the programme is to accelerate change towards sustainable urban mobility.

- **Promotes the market uptake of innovations**, with a strong focus on later-stage solutions (7+ TRL) that are in the final phases of development and ready to be piloted and deployed in the market;
- **Supports businesses in scaling up and commercialising innovative mobility solutions** in collaboration with cities;

# Strategic Innovation Open call

Support projects that are close-to-market, capable of testing new solutions in real-life city demonstrations and that can attain commercial viability by the end of the activities.



**Multi-year framework** (2026-2028) with 5 cut-off dates and 5 focus areas (+ specific topics addressing key market opportunities for specific cut-offs).



**Collaborative and European.** Focus on **ambitious collaborative projects** (2-6 consortium partners) with higher impact and scalability potential.



**Duration**, project set-up and budget adapted to project needs with a **max. of 2M€ of EIT funding** (65% funding intensity) **for up to 24 months.**



**Balanced portfolio of close-to-market solutions and earlier-stage innovations** while ensuring all supported solutions are ready for market deployment by the end of the project.



## **Mandatory KPIs**

1 x EITHE2.4 (marketed innovation) or EITHE4.4 (startup created) and provide a return to EIT Urban Mobility through a Financial Sustainability Mechanism

# Rapid Applications for Transport (RAPTOR) Call

RAPTOR aims to support the development and piloting of cutting-edge solutions, developed by startups and SMEs, to solve niche urban mobility challenges of cities.



## Topics

Niche urban mobility challenges defined by cities around the areas of health and mobility, cycling, zero/low-emission public transport, electrification, mobility data management.



## Type of applicants

Mono-beneficiary call addressed to startups and SMEs established in Member States of the European Union, and/or in third countries associated with Horizon Europe, with urban mobility innovations.



**Participation of cities:** Define niche urban mobility challenges; participate in the evaluation and selection of proposals; provide projects relevant access to software, data, hardware etc; facilitate in-city demonstration of solution and access to infrastructure

# SME Market Expansion Call

The call aims to support SMEs to either develop a new product/service or significantly improve an existing product/service for expansion into a new industry sector or a new geographic area. It provides SMEs with an opportunity to do full usage testing with an end-client within the project implementation.



## Topics

Public Transport, Urban Logistics, Electrification of Transport and Alternative Fuels, Mobility Data Management, and Health and Mobility



## Type of applicants

Mono-beneficiary call addressed to SMEs established in Member States of the European Union, and/or in third countries associated with Horizon Europe, with innovations for urban mobility challenges. Each applicant must have a letter of support from an end-client who will do a full test of the product/service



## Project duration /Budget

7 months /60 000 Eur



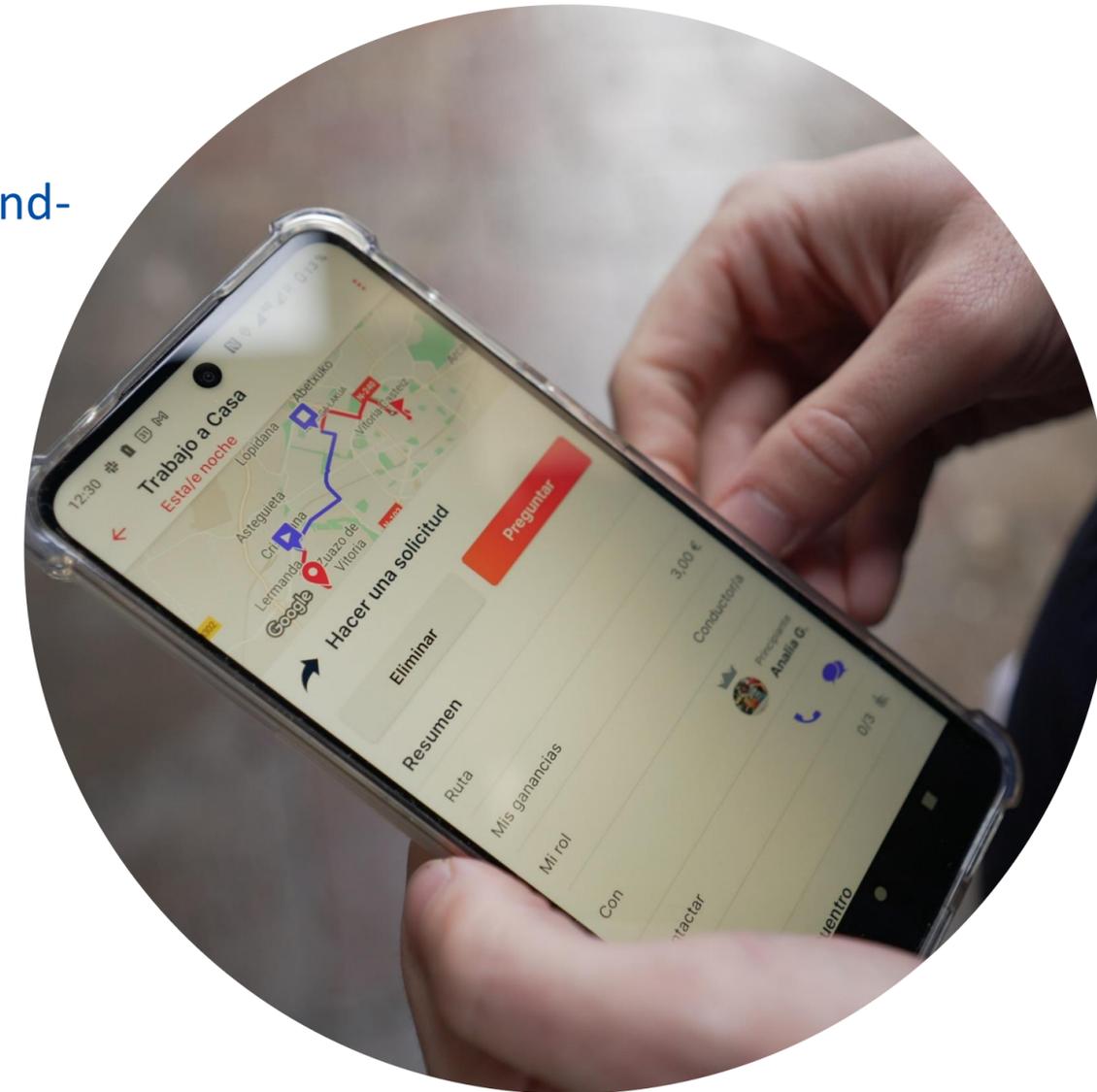
